COVID Safety

The curtain goes up for opening day of the 2021 Longines Golden Slipper Carnival, Chandon Ladies Day – Sydney’s Pink Raceday supporting the McGrath Foundation.

Rosehill Gardens’ time to shine at the Sydney Autumn Carnival begins with the traditional Chandon Ladies Day, and the running of the Group 1 \$600,000 Coolmore Classic for the fillies and mares.

It starts three weeks of world-class racing and entertainment at Rosehill Gardens centred around the world’s richest race for two-year-olds, the Longines Golden Slipper.

The Coolmore Classic gained Group 1 status in 1984, the first race of its kind for females, and over the decades has been won by some of Australia’s greatest fillies and mares.

The raceday also contains the final chances for the two-year-olds to gain automatic entry into the Longines Golden Slipper via the Magic Night (fillies) and the Pago Pago Stakes (colts).

Off the track, the carnival celebration launches with a “pink raceday” in support of the McGrath Foundation with all racegoers encouraged to wear a splash of pink on the day.

The annual Pink Fashion Lunch is the feature social event on Chandon Ladies Day. Host **Samantha Armytage** will talk to a special Women of Influence Panel featuring Director **Rachel Griffiths**

and Actress **Sharon Johal**, there will be a stunning fashion runway while one of Australia’s most popular recording artists and performers **Christine Anu** performs exclusively. **Chase Kojima** from Sokyo will be overseeing the menu.

Fashion Stakes will also return where the competition is open to both ladies and men with an impressive prize pool up for grabs.

The Coolmore Classic is considered the best of the Group 1s for the fillies and mares in Australia.

Often run at a good tempo and with big fields, the handicap conditions add further intrigue around the betting on the race.

Three trainers have dominated this race – Max Lees five wins, Gai Waterhouse’s five winners and Ron Quinton with his superb run as both jockey and trainer.

Tulloch Lodge got back into the big league in 2020 with a former US mare who didn’t succeed at stud and came back into training. Con Te Partiro lapped up the damp conditions to win easily.

- » It has not been a race for favourites with Aloha (2011) the most recent. The shortest priced winner in the last six has been \$15.
- » Ofcourseican (2012) was the last winner not to run in a F&M race as the lead up (Liverpool City Cup). Before her it was Sunline in the Waikato Sprint in 2002.
- » Porto Roca won the 2001 Coolmore Classic. It was Danny O’Brien’s first G1 winner with Damien Oliver aboard and they would go on to combine 18 years later with Miami Bound in the VRC Oaks.
- » The owners of Con Te Partiro agreed to put the mare back into work after she failed to get in foal the previous spring and she won this G1 as a huge reward in 2020.

Two of Sydney's elite jockeys in James McDonald and Hugh Bowman have dominated, winning six of the last eight renewals between them.

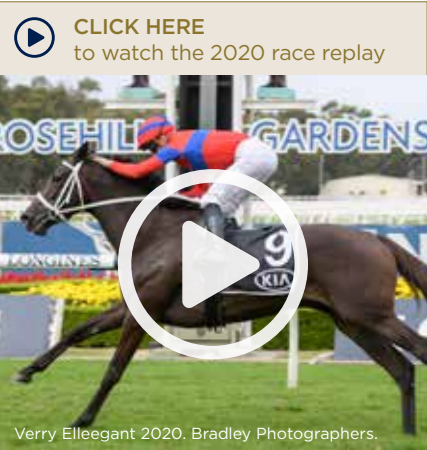

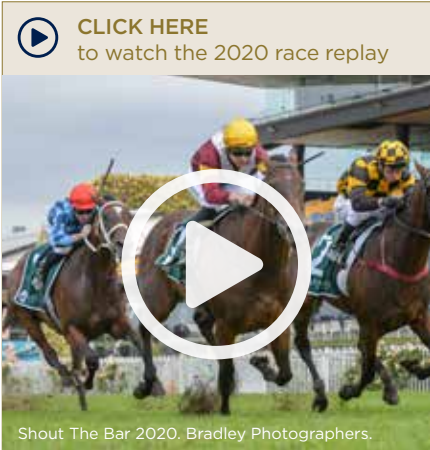

There have also been famous incidents such as the dramatic ‘leg-pull’ in 1961 and an upheld protest in Dulcify’s 1979 victory. Since the race was moved to the Autumn, horses such as Strawberry Road, Bonecrusher, Beau Zam and Octagonal have confirmed its status as Australia’s best Derby.

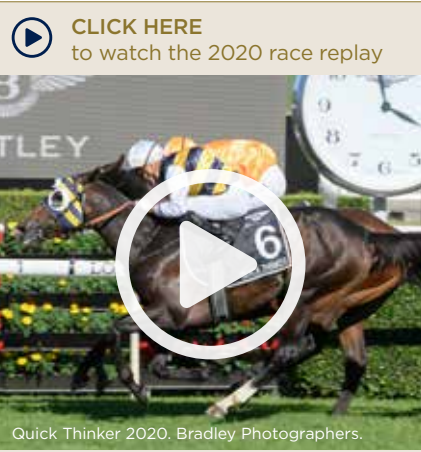

- » ATC Sires/Champagne Stakes double (41) - with the most recent winner being King's Legacy (2020).
- » Six times the Triple Crown was completed in the Champagne Stakes - Baguette (1970), Luskin Star (1977), Tierce (1991), Burst (1992), Dance Hero (2004), Pierro (2012).
- » In 2020, while no horse could complete the Triple Crown, jockey Hugh Bowman was able to achieve that feat winning the Slipper on Farnan and the Sires/Champagne double on King's Legacy.
- » 1957 saw Todman defeat Tulloch reversing the result from the Sires.

2YOs

ANAMOE

2YO colt (Street Boss x Anamato)

TRAINER: James Cummings

There was no margin in his debut victory but it was the manner of it which makes you think he can only improve. Once he balanced up, he attacked the line like a top horse and that was proven once he got to 1200m in the Blue Diamond and in winning the Todman Stakes over many of the other main Longines

FOUR MOVES AHEAD

2YO filly (Snitzel x Doulmera)

TRAINER: John Sargent

Perhaps the best of the fillies heading into the Longines Golden Slipper, she proved she was back in the game with a win in the Sweet Embrace Stakes. A win in the Slipper is certainly a chance but she could also contend in the Inglis Sires and Moët & Chandon Champagne given it hasn't been a long campaign.

PROFITEER

2YO colt (Capitalist x Athena Lass)

TRAINERS: Mick Price & Michael Kent Jnr

He has been so impressive winning by big margins that he must come into Longines Golden Slipper reckoning. While the debut at Flemington was very good, the Inglis Millennium victory was a complete thrashing. Harnessing that obvious speed over the 1200m is his issue now but he was still good in defeat at Randwick in his final lead up run.

TRIFACCIA

2YO filly (I Am Invincible x Mascarer)

TRAINER: James Cummings

A maiden after two runs but won't be a maiden for much longer. Making significant ground in both outings, races such as the two juvenile Group 1s in the Inglis Sires and Moët & Chandon Champagne at Royal Randwick look within her grasp, and her jockeys think she is capable of those sorts of elite performances.

3YOs

AMARELINHA

3YO filly (Savabeel x Hopscotch)

TRAINER: Jamie Richards

Kiwi fillies have a great record in Sydney in the Autumn, especially getting out to the classic trip and this one is bred to get there with ease. Her David & Karyn Ellis Classic win was superb and she then made a long run to take the Sunline Vase. If she gets through the NZ Oaks and being by Savabeel, the Australian Oaks looks a big temptation.

MONTEFILIA

3YO filly (Kermadec x Bana Wu)

TRAINER: David Payne

A dual Group 1 winner in the Spring came in consecutive weeks at Royal Randwick before her Oaks placing. Having beaten the boys in the Spring Champion, it doesn't take much thought to believe at worst she'll challenge in the Australian Oaks and at best run in the Rosehill Guineas and Australian Derby.

MO'UNGA

3YO colt (Savabeel x Chandelier)

TRAINER: Annabel Neasham

A recent change of stable sees him a fascinating competitor in the Sydney Autumn. His dominant Dulcify Quality victory made you think he'd be a Spring Champion contender but they opted for a tilt at the Caulfield Guineas instead. A huge run in the Randwick Guineas, on breeding you'd suspect the Rosehill Guineas is an obvious race to attack and then to the blue riband.

ON THE LEAD

3YO colt (I Am Invincible x Marechal)

TRAINERS: Richard & Michael Freedman

Coming out of the later 3yo Spring sprint races, this colt could be a surprise improver now he is a few months more mature. Something like the Arrowfield 3yo Sprint at The Star Championships looks ideal for him to target as others could be chasing the open age sprints.

WILD RULER

3YO colt (Snitzel x Gypsy Robin)

TRAINERS: Peter & Paul Snowden

Perfectly placed in his career to date, the Snowdens have left him in his own age bracket so far. But once races such as the Galaxy and TJ Smith arrive, he could well come into calculations. The Fireball win was dominant and remember he's already Group 1 placed from the Spring.

4YOs

COLETTE

4YO mare (Hallowed Crown x Libretto)

TRAINER: James Cummings

While her best wins so far have been on damper tracks, it is hard not to be impressed with the way the Oaks winner has translated her form to shorter trips. From near the tail in the Iron Jack Golden Eagle she rocketed home and then took up a position to take the Apollo Stakes first up. Brave in the TAB Chipping Norton too, her versatility could be a very important trait.

FUNSTAR

4YO mare (Adelaide x Starspangled)

TRAINER: Chris Waller

The Chris Waller trained mare won the Phar Lap Stakes last Autumn and then the wins dried up but she has hardly been poor outside of the heavy track on Golden Eagle day. Expect her to be right in races such as the Coolmore Legacy or even The Star Doncaster Mile – a race her trainer has made his own.

LIBERTINI

4YO mare (I Am Invincible x Aloha)

TRAINER: Anthony Cummings

Highly spruiked from the start of her career, things looked to be going backwards this time last year. But another spell saw her return with a dynamic Premiere Stakes victory, beating home the subsequent TAB Everest winner in fast time. She could well be tailor made fresh for the feature Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival sprints.

PROBABEEL

4YO mare (Savabeel x Far Fetched)

TRAINER: Jamie Richards

No stranger to Sydney, this star Kiwi mare has bucked the trend in taking on the shorter trips with great success. Wins at Royal Randwick in the Bill Ritchie and TAB Epsom Handicaps stamped her quality. Her love of Royal Randwick suggests it could either be races such as the Star Doncaster or Longines Queen Elizabeth – or both – as targets.

TRAINER: William Haggas

He did love the softer going but then substantiated the form in taking the Champion Stakes to end the British season at Ascot. He is back in Sydney to take on our very best.

VERRY ELLEEGANT

5YO mare (Zed x Opulence)

TRAINER: Chris Waller

The highest rated galloper in world racing. Trainer William Haggas made a great venture last year and it paid off in both the Ranvet and Longines Queen Elizabeth Stakes. He did love the softer going

HAUT BRION HER

5YO mare (Zoustar x One In A Million)

TRAINER: Chris Waller

Chris Waller's mare went almost 12 months between runs before winning the Sheraco. Two runs later she was asked to contest The TAB Everest and ran a cracking race to just miss the placings. There wasn't much wrong with her effort in the Yes Yes Yes either. That may well have toughened her up to become an elite sprinter.

MUGATOO

6YO gelding (Henrythenavigator x Elopa)

TRAINER: Kris Lees

Mugatoo is ready to take on the big league. Giving Kris Lees his first home town Cup was something but two top runs then backed that up – one under a big weight in the Metropolitan and the other being right there on the corner in the Cox Plate. He will be primed by the time the Royal Randwick part of the carnival comes around.

TO WATCH



BRENTON AVDULLA

Avdulla is ensconced in the top 10 of the Sydney riding ranks and is looking to add to the seven Group 1s on his CV at the start of the Sydney Autumn Carnival. Avdulla's biggest success came in the 2018 Longines Golden Slipper aboard Estijaab.

TOMMY BERRY

Off to a flying first half of the season, Berry is challenging for the prestigious Sydney Metropolitan Jockeys Premiership. His association with the Hawkes Team in Sydney has seen him land top rides on some of the best youngsters. Has won two Longines Golden Slippers.

GLEN BOSS

It would be no surprise to see 'Bossy' landing more Group 1s in the Sydney Autumn. Can he have another The Star Championships run like last year where he won the Schweppes Sydney Cup and The Star Australian Oaks? Boss was won a record seven Doncaster Handicaps.

HUGH BOWMAN

Nearing a significant milestone of 100 Group 1 wins, Bowman may not have Winx anymore but it did not stop him this time last year when he made even more history. He was able to ride the 2YO Triple Crown (Golden Slipper on Farnan and the Sires/Champagne double on King's Legacy).

TIM CLARK

A much respected rider, his ability on a leader is from the top drawer. Clark won three Group 1s over the last Sydney Autumn all on mares - Con Te Partiro (Coolmore Classic), I Am Excited (The Galaxy) and Con Te Partiro (Queen Of The Turf Stakes).

JASON COLLETT

Collett has gone to a new level in recent seasons within the hugely competitive Sydney jockey ranks. After winning his first Group 1 last year, Collett went on to notch a second major in the Sydney Spring aboard filly Montefilia in the Moët & Chandon Spring Champion Stakes.

JAMIE KAH

With an extraordinary start to 20/21, Jamie Kah is rightfully considered not just a leading female jockey but a leading jockey full stop. Frequently riding doubles and trebles, she added to her Group 1 tally in the Melbourne spring. If she heads to Sydney, she will be in great demand.

RACHEL KING

As female riders make waves around the land, King is doing just that in such a tough environment as Sydney. Her first Australian Group 1 was for Mark Newnham but an organisation such as Godolphin has no hesitation in using her in big races.

JAMES McDONALD

Sydney's leading jockey rode some of the country's best horses through the Spring - including multiple Group 1 winning mare Verry Elleegant. A four-time winner of the Sydney Metropolitan Jockeys Premiership, McDonald took out the 2014 Longines Golden Slipper on Mossfun.

KERRIN McEVOY

After winning the Melbourne Cup on Brew at just 20, Kerrin McEvoy continues to win big races around the land. His historic back to back wins on Redzel in the first two runnings of The TAB Everest are already folklore. He's got another chance to win the grand prize on Classique Legend and has begun an association with the promising three-year-old Peltzer.

TRAINERS TO WATCH

JAMES CUMMINGS



Godolphin consistently has great strength and depth across all age groups, from the youngsters in the Longines Golden Slipper, to the classic three year olds, through to the Weight-for-age stars 1200m to 2000m and beyond. Everest runner-up Bivoauc and The Star Australian Oaks/Iron Jack Golden Eagle winner Colette will be just two stable superstars to watch through the Autumn.

MICHAEL, WAYNE & JOHN HAWKES



Every season Hawkes Racing has success but in particular with young horses. The family training partnership has already won two Longines Golden Slippers, and has youngster Remarque heading another strong team. Amongst a stable of stars, up and coming filly Written Beauty could well be their newest Group 1 winner.

KRIS LEES



Kris Lees may train outside of Sydney but his Newcastle base consistently prepares a big team of high-quality Carnival horses. The Lees name has a superb relationship with the fillies and mares as seen with Samantha Miss and Lucia Valentina but many of his team's new brigade have started their careers overseas with staying credentials.

CIARON MAHER & DAVID EUSTACE



The leaders of the title race in Victoria are going to have a huge influence through the Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival as well. Maher and Eustace took a giant scalp with Sir Dragonet in the Cox Plate but with their large bank of juvenile talent, it is hard to see them not playing a big hand in the two and three year old Group 1s, including the Longines Golden Slipper.

MARK NEWNHAM



One of the rising stars of the Sydney training ranks, Newnham is now firmly established in his own right after many years with Gai Waterhouse. With a couple of Carnival Group 1s already to his name, Newnham also comes off a hot summer streak, particularly within the staying ranks.

PETER & PAUL SNOWDEN



The Snowdens are amongst the very best in Australia in producing a number of high quality two and three year olds who always measure up in the Group 1s. Last Autumn they won two legs of the Sydney two year old triple Crown as King's Legacy took out the Inglis Sires/Moët & Chandon Champagne double. The father and son team have a recent Longines Golden Slipper winner in Capitalist.

CHRIS WALLER



The ten-time Sydney trainers champion and season leading trainer of G1s yet again featured heavily last year as he added another of the 'majors' with the Caulfield Cup. That was from Verry Elleegant and she, along with Nature Strip, are just two big names. Three year old September Rain is emerging as one of the brightest new stars.

GAI WATERHOUSE & ADRIAN BOTT



After a couple of years without a major, Tulloch Lodge roared back by taking out five in 2020 including a record seventh Longines Golden Slipper for the legendary Gai with Farnan. Shout The Bar and Con Te Partiro provided two Group 1s each and there is little doubt the Waterhouse and Bott team will again feature prominently across Rosehill Gardens and Royal Randwick.

But, if you're wearing a bright colour or busy pattern, only add a hint of neutral colour to the face and blend/dab any excess lip oil to the apple of the cheeks.

Tip: The shine of a lip oil will also promote a fuller lip look, as it reflects light for that perfect Autumn pout!

HOW TO GET TO THE TRACK

ROSEHILL GARDENS

Rosehill Gardens is situated approximately 20km to the west of the Sydney CBD in what is the geographical heart of the city.

Three of the city's major vehicular arteries – Parramatta Road, Victoria Road and the M4 Motorway service Rosehill Gardens.

Scheduled bus services run to Rosehill Gardens from Parramatta Station and Sydney Olympic Park, with increased services for raceday patrons.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Train Services

Trains run regularly to Parramatta where you can connect with buses to Rosehill Gardens.

Buses to/from Carlingford and Parramatta Station

Train replacement bus services (535 route) will operate daily with frequent stops from Valentine Avenue, Parramatta to Lloyds Avenue, Carlingford via Hassall Street, Rosehill.

The M92 service also operates to and from Parramatta Station.

There will be no disruption to accessing the P1, P3, P4 and P5 car parks, and the Rosehill footbridge will remain open for entry to the property.

TAXI/RIDE SHARE

Set Down – Taxis enter Rosehill Gardens Racecourse through the Grand Avenue gates. The set-down point is at the taxi rank. Taxis are not permitted to stop on James Ruse Drive and Grand Ave.

Pick Up – Taxis are located at the Grand Avenue end of the racecourse adjacent to the Might and Power entry.

HIRE CARS & LIMOUSINES

Limousines enter Rosehill Gardens Racecourse via the Gate 1 P1 Members Entry. Set-down and pick-up is available. Please follow directions from gate staff. Onsite parking is not available.

CAR PARKING

There is limited FREE car parking in P4 / P5 car park located on James Ruse Drive & Prospect Street and P6 Infield car park. Entry to the Infield car park is via Gate 2 Unwin Street.

ROYAL RANDWICK

Royal Randwick is located on Alison Road in Sydney's Eastern Suburbs and is approximately 6km from Sydney CBD and 8km from Sydney Airport.

Royal Randwick is well serviced by public transport with Light Rail services running from Circular Quay and Central to Royal Randwick station, and a purpose built bus terminal and slipway located immediately outside the main racecourse entrance on Alison Road.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Light Rail

The new L2 or L3 Randwick Line services run between Circular Quay and Randwick via Central Station (Chalmers Street).

Catch a light rail service to the Royal Randwick stop on Alison Road which is opposite the racecourse or the L3 which arrives at Ascot Street Gate. Services run regularly from 5.00am until 1.00am on weekdays and weekends. During major events, frequent express shuttle services will also run.

Buses

Plenty of regular route buses also run between the City and Eastern Suburbs via Anzac Parade and Alison Road to get you to Randwick Racecourse including Routes M50, 339, 373, 374, 376 and 377.

TAXI/RIDE SHARE & HIRE CAR

Taxis enter Royal Randwick through the Ascot St gates. The set-down and collection point is at the secure taxi rank.

Hire Car Collection is permitted via Gate 1 on Alison Road AFTER 3.00pm.

Hire cars are advised that there is a STRICT 15 minute collection/waiting time. Please have your pre-booked passengers waiting at the Hire Car collection bay (GATE D) prior to entering the precinct.

Taxis, ride share and hire cars are not permitted to stop on Alison Rd or Doncaster Avenue.

RideShare – please follow instructions from your preferred rideshare app. Patrons are advised that rideshare will only be permitted to collect from designated safe zones external to the venue.

CAR PARKING

There is limited FREE car parking in the infield car park. Entry to the infield car park is via High Street, opposite UNSW.

The Ascot Street Multi Deck carpark is available for the use of Australian Turf Club members ONLY. Pre-booking is required for all days, please contact the Membership for information.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT COVIDSAFE REMINDER

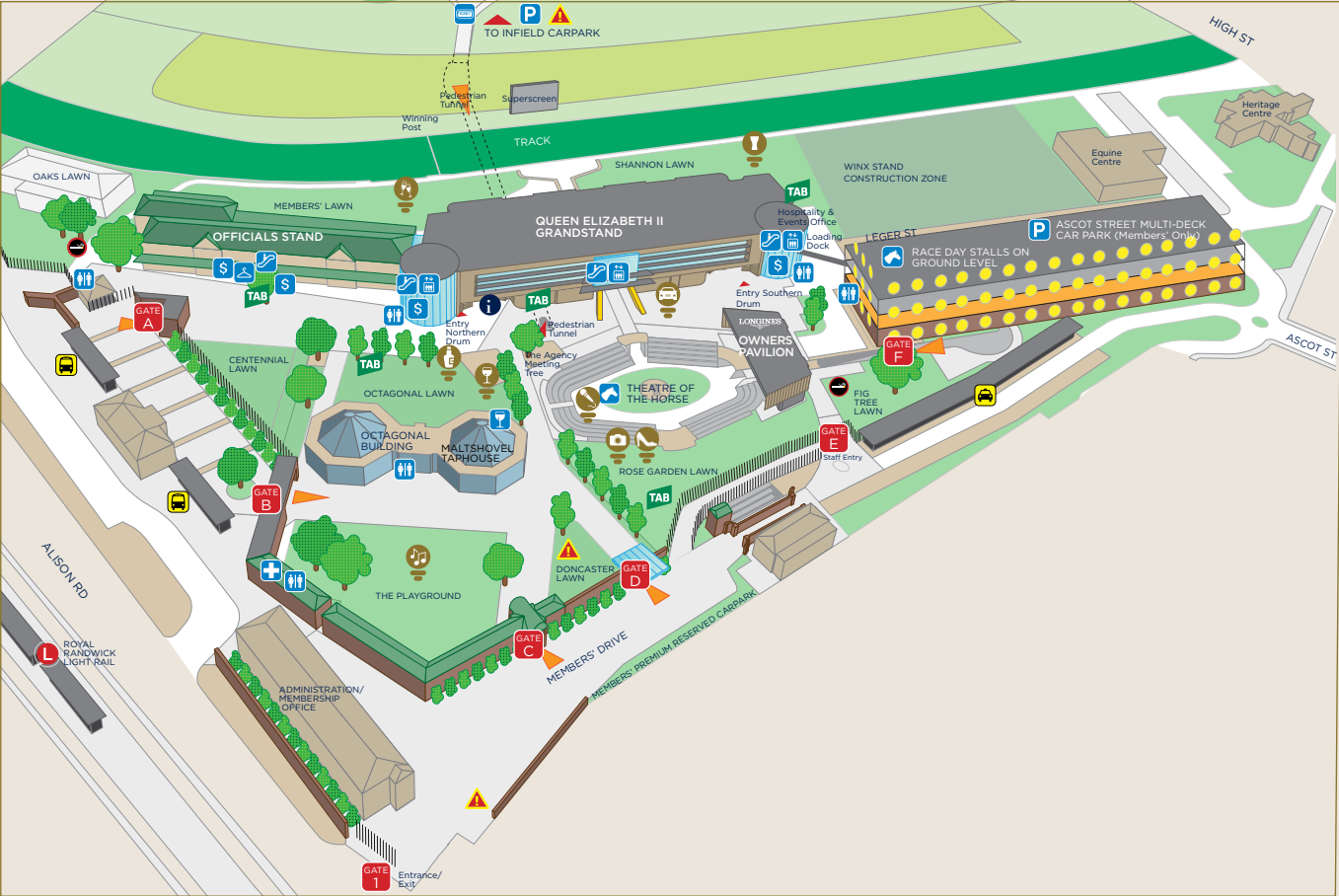
Racegoers travelling by public transport are reminded that services continue to operate at a reduced capacity to maintain physical distancing across the network.
