Prizemoney for the Group 1 Fujitsu General George Main Stakes rises to \$1 million this year and the race remains a key form guide towards the \$1.5 million TAB Epsom.

Modern-day superstars such as Kingston Town, Vo Rogue, Lonhro and Winx have won the race.

After Winx won three times in a row in recent years, multiple Group 1 winner and inaugural Golden Eagle champion Kolding last year added a George Main to his imposing record.

The \$1 million XXXX Golden Rose is the richest Group 1 race in the Sydney Spring for 3yo sprinters and has become a major target for colts.

As a natural Spring aim following the Longines Golden Slipper in Autumn, it's place on the calendar now allows further options up and back in distance including the TAB Everest.

Yes Yes finished second to star sprinter Bivoauc before he took out the world's richest race on turf in 2019.

Last year, Hawkes Racing's two gun colts Ole Kirk (full sister to the champ Black Caviar) and North Pacific fought out a compelling dual – adding further lustre to breeding appeal around the Golden Rose.

The new headline race of the Sydney Spring has already confirmed the egalitarian nature of racing in Australia, a syndicate won the first two editions (along with their slot holder) with Redzel.

It was the baby of the field in 2019 as Yes Yes Came from near last in track record time to win for Australian racing superstars in jockey Glen Boss and trainer Chris Waller.

In 2020, it was arguably the race's most dominant winner yet as the flashy grey Classique Legend raced away to win by 2.5 lengths.

Colette was primed to run well in 2020 and then it rained which she loved even more. Still it took the entire length of the Rosehill straight to grab the massive first prize.


