CHAIRMAN'S WELCOME



THE AUSTRALIAN TURF CLUB WELCOMES MEDIA TO ONE OF THE WORLD'S STRONGEST AND MOST PRESTIGIOUS RACING EVENTS, THE 2022 SYDNEY AUTUMN RACING CARNIVAL.

Six weeks at Rosehill Gardens and Royal Randwick where more than \$37 million prizemoney will be won including 18 Group 1s, all part of 48 Black Type races.

Amongst these Group 1 races is Sydney's iconic Longines Golden Slipper, with the 66th running of the world's richest race for two-year-olds now offering increased total prizemoney of \$5 million.

This stakes uplift of \$1.5 million from the Australian Turf Club and Racing NSW further elevates the importance of the Longines Golden Slipper to the Australian racing and breeding industry, whilst also making it Sydney's richest Autumn race.

In addition, the Australian Turf Club is offering a further \$1 million bonus to connections if they win two of five selected pathway races as well as the ultimate prize itself, the Longines Golden Slipper.

It is one of many highlights over these six weeks.

At the start of this year eleven Australian Turf Club races – nine of which are run in Autumn – were officially rated in the top 100 Group 1 races in the world by the International Federation of Horseracing Authorities (IFHA) and Longines at the World Racing Awards.

This is the most of any Club in international racing – an extraordinary achievement itself.

For the fourth consecutive year the \$4 million Longines Queen Elizabeth Stakes at Royal Randwick during The Star Championships was the highest rated overall race in Australia.

The world's official highest rated sprint race is run at the Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival – the \$2.5 million TJ Smith Stakes.

Added to this list during the six-week Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival is the \$3 million The Star Doncaster Mile, \$1 million The Agency George Ryder Stakes, \$700,000 Ranvet Stakes, \$600,000 Schweppes All Aged Stakes and \$600,000 Sky Racing Active Rosehill Guineas.

These races alone truly make the Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival a world-class racing event, yet they are supported by

a host of other feature races at Rosehill Gardens and Royal Randwick.

The quality on the track is matched by the award-winning food, hospitality and fashion on racedays in all of Sydney's style and sophistication.

This year sees the launch of Where Stories Are Made, an Australian Turf Club initiative which recognizes the unique social attraction of a day at the track, where shared experiences on a raceday turn into lifelong memories.

No other event in Sydney brings together world-class sport, entertainment, fashion and hospitality like a Carnival raceday.

We will be encouraging our guests to share their own stories, celebrating the racing industry's passion and dedication, the fashion and entertainment off the track, as you the media also relate your own stories to audiences across the world.

The Australian Turf Club is also delighted to continue Sydney's official annual Pink Fashion Lunch at Rosehill Gardens, proudly supporting the McGrath Foundation, as part of the opening day of the Carnival and the running of the Group 1 \$600,000 Coolmore Classic.

And in another innovation of the Australian Turf Club, which in recent years has inspired race clubs around the world, is the on-course and online Autumn Fashion Stakes and Longines Prize For Elegance, offering a share in \$30,000 cash and prizes.

I thank media for their support of our racing and events and look forward to joining you as one of the world's great cities hosts this spectacular six weeks on and off the track.

The \$37 million Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival begins at Rosehill Gardens with the three-week Longines Golden Slipper Carnival on Chandon Ladies Day.

The Group 1 \$600,000 Coolmore Classic brings together Australia's best fillies and mares under handicap conditions in a race that was the first of its type to reach Group 1 status.

The Coolmore Classic regularly attracts a capacity field and a strong betting race, and has been won by champions such as Emancipation, Bounding Away, Sunline (twice) and Typhoon Tracy.

The day also features the Group 3 \$175,000 Cellarbrations Magic Night Stakes and Group 3 \$175,000 Bowermans Pago Pago Stakes - the final chances for two-year-olds to automatically qualify for the Group 1 \$5 million Longines Golden Slipper.

It is run fast and produces quality efforts. However punters have found it hard with seven double figure winners on the trot.

Three have dominated this race - Max Lees with his five wins, Gai Waterhouse as part of five winners and Ron Quinton with his superb run as both jockey and trainer took out six of them.

It was a day for the Queenslanders in 2021 as Tony Gollan provided Krone with a flashing light this year starting on the Gold Coast and ending in G1 success.

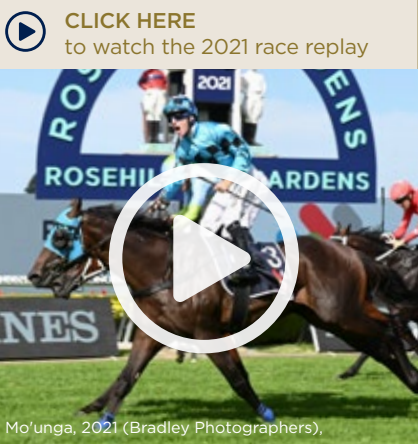

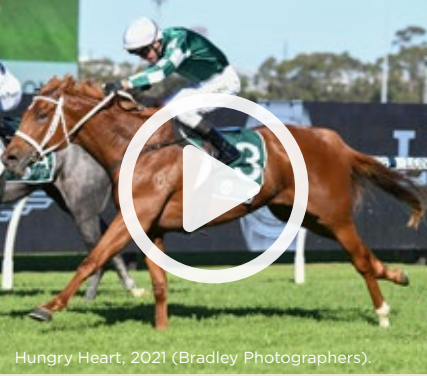

It was another speed test in 2021 as Nature Strip went back to back beating the field by the same margin he did twelve months prior.

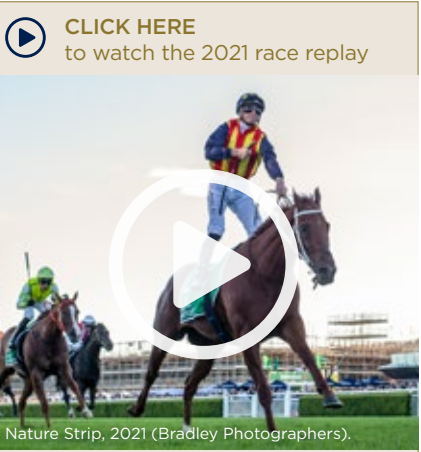

The form came from left field in 2021 as the Tasmanian Derby winner Explosive Jack would win three runs later, coming from near last to get the bob of the head in a three way finish.

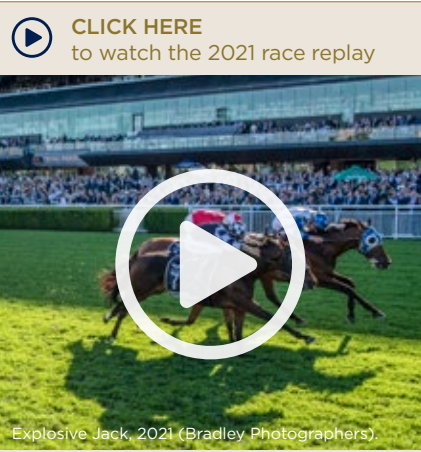

In 2019, Cox Plate form as well as G1 sprinting form emanated from this race and in 2020 a promising colt did the Sires/Champagne double.

King's Legacy showed he could handle it wet or dry, from 1200m to 1600m and racing forward or coming from the back of the field.

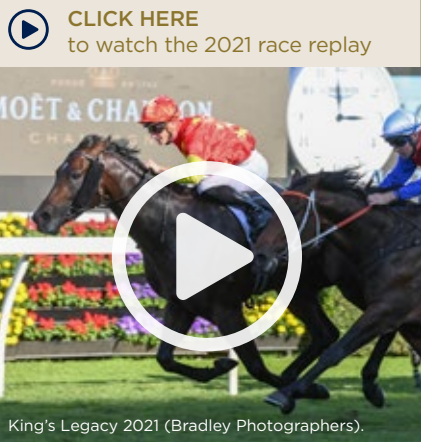

COOLANGATTA

2YO filly (Written Tycoon x Piping Hot)

Trainers: Ciaran Maher & David Eustace

In some seasons one juvenile stands out and immediately makes a huge impression, remaining a Longines Golden Slipper for many months. Her dominant win in the Gimcrack Stakes at Royal Randwick and a strong Magic Millions victory over the 1200m has her heading to the ultimate prize - the \$5 million Longines Golden Slipper.

JACQUINOT

2YO colt (Rubick x Ponterro)

Trainers: Mick Price & Michael Kent Jnr

His debut victory caught the eye coming off the pace in a big field - something regularly seen in winners of the Longines Golden Slipper over many decades. Has had little luck in two subsequent races including the Blue Diamond Stakes when a close third. With a very astute stable who always have a top-flight youngster in Autumn.

MAGIC

2YO colt (Snitzel x Rising Romance)

Trainers: Michael, Wayne & John Hawkes

At \$2.5 million, this high-profile colt was the highest priced yearling sold in Australia in 2021 at the Inglis Easter Yearling sale. Made a long-awaited debut in the Group 2 Fujitsu General Silver Slipper Stakes at Rosehill Gardens, with an unlucky and fast-finishing second. With a Longines Golden Slipper winning stable, Magic is set to feature in all of the two-year-old Group 1 races.

SEJARDAN

2YO colt (Sebring x Miss Amajardan)

Trainer: Gary Portelli

Gary Portelli is a renowned trainer of two-year-olds and already has a Longines Golden Slipper on the CV with She Will Reign. Sejardan finished powerfully to win a Breeders Plate on debut and followed with a similar run to win the \$1 million Inglis Rural Property Golden Gift at Rosehill Gardens. Lost no admirers with a third in the \$2 million Inglis Millennium and victory in UNSW Todman Stakes.

SHALATIN

2YO colt (Shalaa x Arcadia Delight)

Trainer: Joe Pride

Has a similar racing style and form around Sejardan and his second in the \$1 million Inglis Rural Property Golden Gift stamped this colt as an ideal Longines Golden Slipper type. Wasn't fully suited in the Group 2 Fujitsu General Silver Slipper and with such an astute trainer will be well placed in any of the two-year-old features .

3YOs

ANAMOE

3YO colt (Street Boss x Anamato)

Trainer: James Cummings

His 2YO form was excellent and 3YO form even better, marking him one of the rising stars of Australian racing. Last Autumn Anamoe built on his Group 1 Inglis Sires victory, before showing in Spring some of his best races are deeper into a preparation. Has been at the top of TAB markets for several Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival events, including the \$4 million Longines Queen Elizabeth Stakes.

CONVERGE

3YO gelding (Frankel x Conversely)

Trainer: Gai Waterhouse & Adrian Bott

After winning his first Group 1 last year, an infection curtailed Converge's Sydney Spring Carnival campaign. Comes into the Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival with the middle to longer distance races in mind and Group 1s such as the \$600,000 Sky Racing Rosehill Guineas and \$3 million The Star Doncaster Mile would seem ideal for the son of superstar Frankel.

FANGIRL

3YO filly (Sebring x Little Surfer Girl)

Trainer: Chris Waller

From the all-conquering 11-time Sydney Premiership winning stable of Chris Waller, Fangirl has built an impressive record for a horse who needs some luck from back in the field. Stunning return in the Group 2 TAB Light Fingers sets up a Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival campaign which will target several of the Group 1 features for the fairer sex.

HOME AFFAIRS

3YO colt (I Am Invincible x Miss Interiors)

Trainer: Chris Waller

One of the most promising sprinters in Australia, he was given a chance to show his immense talent by taking on the world's best sprinters in the \$15 million TAB Everest in Spring at just his sixth race start. Has since won two Group 1 races including nudging out stablemate and his TAB Everest winner Nature Strip. Will make the \$2.5 million TJ Smith Stakes one of the races of the Autumn.

PAULELE

3YO colt (Dawn Approach x Chatoyant)

Trainer: James Cummings

Another promising young colt from the powerful Godolphin team, trainer James Cummings didn't rush him into a TAB Everest. He returned with a good win in the Group 3 Eskimo Prince - maintaining a perfect record at Royal Randwick. Handles all conditions and will be amongst favourites for all 3YO races and could even have a tilt at a TJ Smith Stakes.

4YOs

COUNT DE RUPEE

4YO gelding (Real Impact x Timeless Choice)

Trainers: Robert & Luke Price

This Kembla Grange trained 4YO quickly rose to great heights when they started to stretch him out in distance. Just run down in the \$7.5 million XXXX Golden Eagle at Rosehill Gardens, regular jockey Brock Ryan rode a perfect race to claim the \$1 million The Gong at the end of Spring. Ready to rise to Group 1 levels in races such as the \$1 million The Agency George Ryder and \$3 million The Star Doncaster Mile.

I'M THUNDERSTRUCK

4YO gelding (Shocking x Primadonna Girl)

Trainers: Mick Price & Michael Kent Jnr

Another highly progressive horse in this strong stable, I'm Thunderstruck took out the \$7.5 million XXXX Golden Eagle which already boasts an honour roll of multiple Group 1 winners. As a rising four-year-old will be heading for weight for age races such as the \$1 million The Agency George Ryder and then has 55.5kg in the \$3 million The Star Doncaster Mile.

MO'UNGA

4YO horse (Savabeel x Chandelier)

Trainer: Annabel Neasham

After a cracking Winx Stakes win on resumption, the entire didn't manage to score after that but he ran elite races every time and all at G1 level. It was basically all the best horses in training that finished ahead of him. Last year he ran in The Star Doncaster Mile and Longines Queen Elizabeth as a 3YO but with more experience, he can take on both those races this time and be right with them again.

LOST AND RUNNING

5YO gelding (Per Incanto x Dreamlife)

Traine: John O'Shea

Early slotted for the \$15 million TAB Everest, he kept improving all the way through his Spring preparation, finishing fourth in the world's strongest sprint race. Lost and Running was dominant in a first up victory at Royal Randwick. Look for him in the \$1 million The Agency George Ryder and \$600,000 Schweppes All Aged Stakes.

MASKED CRUSADER

5YO gelding (Toronado x She's Got Gears)

Trainers: Michael, Wayne & John Hawkes

The stable often have a target and they peak to their fullest ability that day. Masked Crusader did that but was a head away from the result in the \$15 million TAB Everest. He may well also have finished closer with a tad more luck in the TJ Smith 12 months back and that is a very probable goal during the Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival.

NATURE STRIP

7YO gelding (Nicconi x Strikeline)

Trainer: Chris Waller

The world's highest rated sprinter reached the summit in October and finally conquered the \$15 million TAB Everest. Now if anything as a rising 7YO, his Autumn form has been as good, if not better and he continues on a Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival campaign and a date with destiny for a third consecutive Group 1 \$2.5 million TJ Smith Stakes.

VERRY ELLEEGANT

6YO mare (Zed x Opulence)

Trainer: Chris Waller

Sydney's leading trainer has a new champion mare in the stable with the latest Australian Horse Of The Year. Verry Elleegant has claimed an 11th Group 1 this year already in the \$600,000 TAB Chipping Norton Stakes off the back of a victorious Melbourne Cup campaign. Looks to add to a remarkable record in the Group 1 \$700,000 Ranvet Stakes and \$4 million Longines Queen Elizabeth Stakes.

HUGH BOWMAN

Already an all-time great and household name with the immortal Winx, Bowman smashed through a landmark, becoming only the fourth jockey in Australian history to ride more than 100 Group 1s. Comes to the Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival in sparkling form. Looking for a second Longines Golden Slipper.

TIM CLARK

Always renowned for his front running skill, Tim Clark was able to win some feature races off the pace last Autumn. Krone did that in the Coolmore Classic but his horse for the Sydney autumn could well be Converge for Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott. "Top Cat" Clark starts the season with 18 career Group 1s.

JASON COLLETT

More than 50 metro winners last season showed Jason Collett's standing in the Sydney ranks had continued to rise. He won the Group 1 Moët & Chandon Spring Champion last autumn on Montefilia, a multiple Group 1 winning mare whom he teams up with again. Firmly established in Sydney's top 10 riders.

He maintains a relationship with some of the best horses in the land including Nature Strip and Verry Elleegant. Swept past 50 Group 1s last Autumn at a young age and was dominant again in Spring.

KERRIN McEVOY

When you've won three of the four TAB Everests alongside three Melbourne Cups and a Longines Golden Slipper, you are in the all-time top echelon of riders. Kerrin will find plenty of leading Group 1 chances to add to his tally of 79 this Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival.

NASH RAWILLER

It's no surprise that Nash Rawiller would get on well with a tough, on-pace horse and that is what happened in the second half of the year with Eduardo, one of his star rides this Autumn. Has also built an affinity with Think It Over, developing as one of the nation's best.

Hawkes Racing continues to focus on quality over quantity and every Carnival produces some super talent, especially amongst the colts. Also won a Longines Golden Slipper with Mossfun.



ANNABEL NEASHAM

A rising star in one of the world's strongest and most competitive centres, Annabel Neasham already has three Group 1 victories to her name in just over 12 months as a trainer in Sydney. Stable stars such as Mo'unga and Zaaki have lead her charge but with the backing of the Aquis operation she will have the opportunity to unearth even more talent.

JOE PRIDE

Always a strong player at this time of year, Pride had a stellar Spring with top flight horses winning top flight races. From a sprinter in Eduardo through to Private Eye in the TAB Epsom he was taking plenty of prizemoney home. Then add Brutality who gained an exemption into the The Star Doncaster Mile via the Villiers, and you have another force in the world-class Sydney training ranks.

PETER & PAUL SNOWDEN

You can bet when it comes to this time of year that the Snowdens will be right in the reckoning with the talent in the young brigade. So many times they've taken out one or more of the juvenile features plus with the classic generation runners as well. Peter had 29 G1s under his own leadership and then another 16 with son Paul.



CHRIS WALLER

An 11-time Sydney Metropolitan Trainers Premiership champion, Chris Waller sets the bar like no other. While inextricably linked to the immortal Winx, Waller is already breaking a host of training records with horses and races across the board. A stable full of stars headed by world's highest rated sprinter Nature Strip, 11-time Group 1 winner Verry Elleegant and emerging Home Affairs.

GAI WATERHOUSE & ADRIAN BOTT

While Gai is a household name and with 134 Group 1s in her own right, her partnership at Tulloch Lodge with Adrian Bott only continues to prosper. An incredible record with most of their biggest wins so far with fillies and mares, they did take the Golden Rose with In The Congo in the Spring. Converge could well make a huge impression this Autumn.

BJORN BAKER

The Stable just had one of its most successful seasons yet, finishing third behind powerhouses of Chris Waller Racing and Godolphin on the 2020/21 Sydney Metropolitan Trainers Premiership. While the stable didn't win a Group 1 and perhaps lacks a headline horse, it often has success with the fillies and mares and can also produce tough, competitive on-pace runners and stayers. She's Ideal looks their next star.

If you miss the important corrective step and add a lighter shade concealer only on dark circles, the area can start to look grey.

Step 1: Apply three dots of the corrective shade on the visible dark circle, from inner tear duct to the centre of the under-eye.

Step 2: Blend the dots together in a dapping, press and roll action to conceal and correct.

Step 3: Repeat the above, but now with the lighter shade to brighten.

Avoid concealing too far on the outer under-eye and top of the cheek bone, as this may cause product to build up and crease in long wear situations.



BOLD LIP

When it comes to Autumn beauty, don't be afraid to add a pop of colour, especially when it has a matte texture. Use rich tones with creamy matte finishes rather than pastels with high shine to really bring the Autumn glam.

Your lip shade should mirror the tones present in your outfit, pick a shade that complements the colours, without matching too much, and bring that to the lip and cheek area for a beauty and fashion connection. As long as not everything is too matching it will still pull focus.

For our The Championships Day 2 – Longines Queen Elizabeth Stakes Day look, I focused on bringing an orange tone lip to life to complement the outfit. The use of a slightly deeper lip liner in a non-shine formula and a similar toned blush really brought the fun to this Autumn look.

METALLIC EYE

One of the big trends is metallic shadow to really dress up the eye. Whether it's a metallic wash of colour over the entire eyelid, or a small, concentrated amount on the central part of the eyelid to pop the eye, the choice is yours.

When paired with depth matte shadows to give eye definition, the metallic shadow gives a dramatic contrast that lifts the glam on any eye makeup, adding a rich element for any Autumn look.

Find a shade that compliments your overall eye look, but still contrasts from the existing base shades used. Use your fingertip to apply the shadow and slowly massage and press onto the eyelid, as using brushes runs the risk of flicking pigment which will result in fall-out on the face.

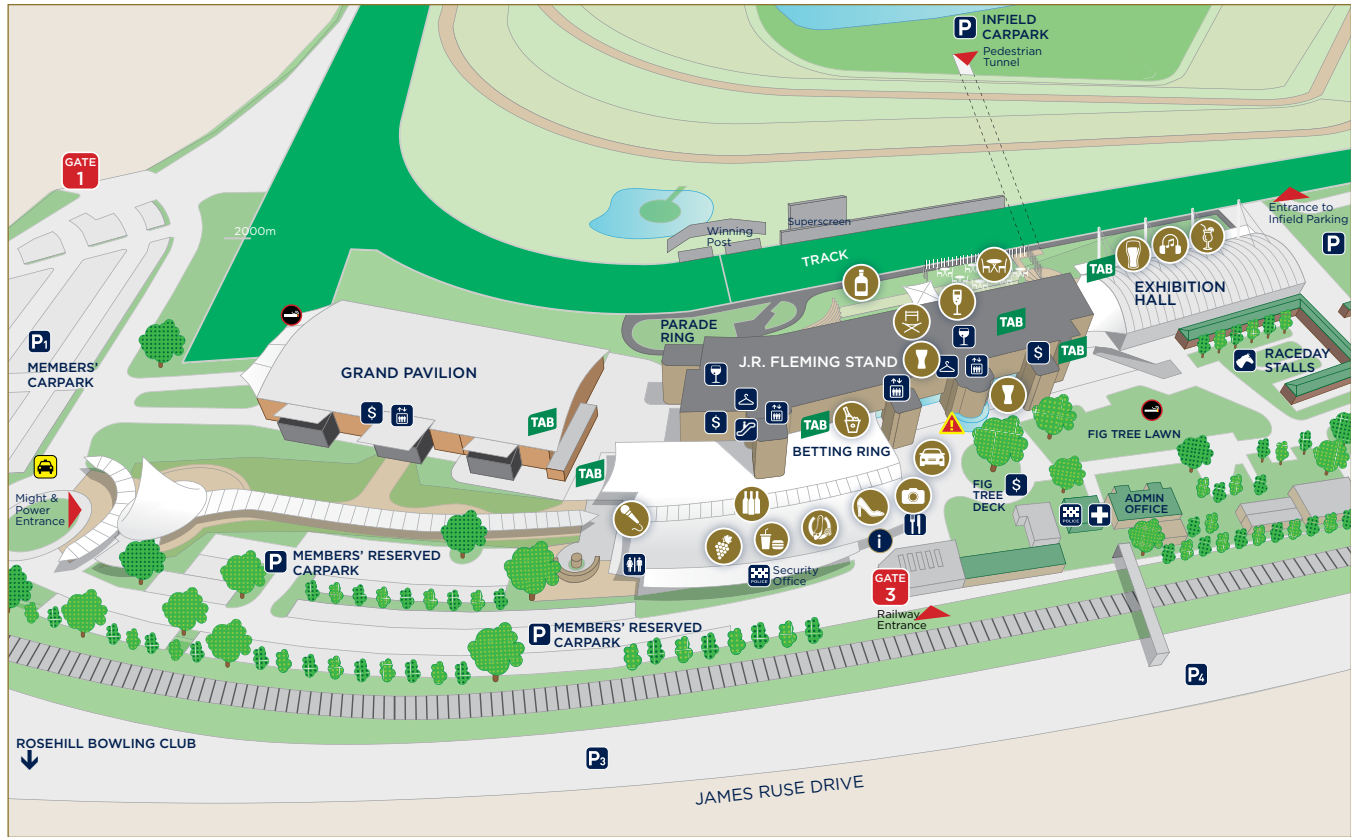

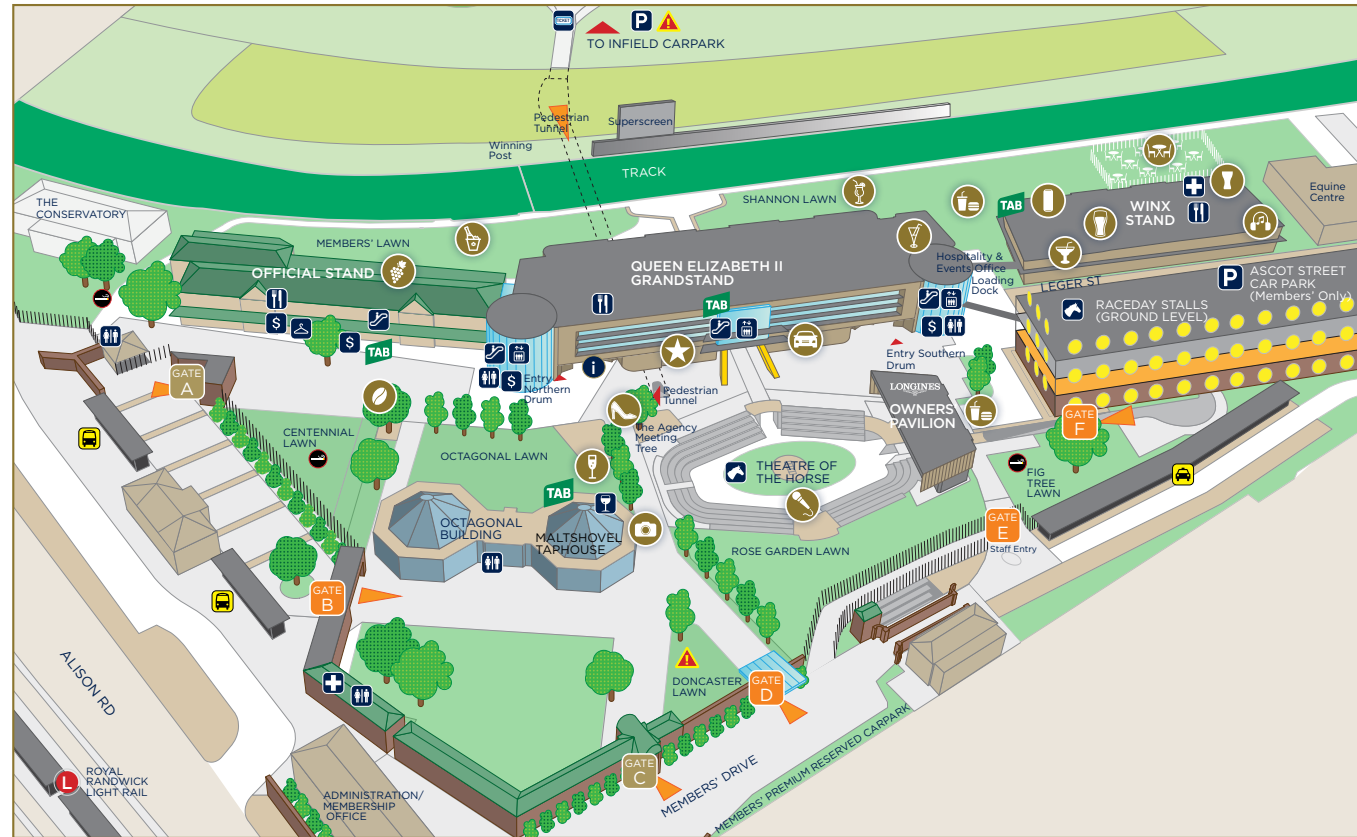

HOW TO GET TO THE TRACK

ROSEHILL GARDENS

Rosehill Gardens is situated approximately 20km to the west of the Sydney CBD in what is the geographical heart of the city.

Three of the city's major vehicular arteries – Parramatta Road, Victoria Road and the M4 Motorway service Rosehill Gardens.

Scheduled bus services run to Rosehill Gardens from Parramatta Station and Sydney Olympic Park, with increased services for raceday patrons.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Train Services

Trains run regularly to Parramatta where you can connect with buses to Rosehill Gardens.

Buses to/from Carlingford and Parramatta Station

Train replacement bus services (535 route) will operate daily with frequent stops from Valentine Avenue, Parramatta to Lloyds Avenue, Carlingford via Hassall Street, Rosehill.

The M92 service also operates to and from Parramatta Station.

There will be no disruption to accessing the P1, P3 and P4 car parks, and the Rosehill footbridge will remain open for entry to the property.

TAXI/RIDE SHARE

Set Down – Taxis enter Rosehill Gardens Racecourse through the Grand Avenue gates. The set-down point is at the taxi rank. Taxis are not permitted to stop on James Ruse Drive and Grand Ave.

Pick Up – Taxis are located at the Grand Avenue end of the racecourse adjacent to the Might and Power entry.

HIRE CARS & LIMOUSINES

Limousines enter Rosehill Gardens Racecourse via the Gate 1 P1 Members Entry. Set-down and pick-up is available. Please follow directions from gate staff. Onsite parking is not available.

CAR PARKING

There is limited FREE car parking in P4 / P5 car park located on James Ruse Drive & Prospect Street and P6 Infield car park. Entry to the Infield car park is via Gate 2 Unwin Street.

ROYAL RANDWICK

Royal Randwick is located on Alison Road in Sydney's Eastern Suburbs and is approximately 6km from Sydney CBD and 8km from Sydney Airport.

Royal Randwick is well serviced by public transport with Light Rail services running from Circular Quay and Central to Royal Randwick station, and a purpose built bus terminal and slipway located immediately outside the main racecourse entrance on Alison Road.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Light Rail

The new L2 or L3 Randwick Line services run between Circular Quay and Randwick via Central Station (Chalmers Street).

Catch a light rail service to the Royal Randwick stop on Alison Road which is opposite the racecourse or the L3 which arrives at Ascot Street Gate. Services run regularly from 5.00am until 1.00am on weekdays and weekends. During major events, frequent express shuttle services will also run.

Buses

Plenty of regular route buses also run between the City and Eastern Suburbs via Anzac Parade and Alison Road to get you to Randwick Racecourse including Routes M50, 339, 373, 374, 376 and 377.

TAXI/RIDE SHARE & HIRE CAR

Taxis enter Royal Randwick through the Ascot St gates. The set-down and collection point is at the secure taxi rank.

Hire Car Collection is permitted via Gate 1 on Alison Road AFTER 3.00pm.

Hire cars are advised that there is a STRICT 15 minute collection/waiting time. Please have your pre-booked passengers waiting at the Hire Car collection bay (GATE D) prior to entering the precinct.

Taxis, ride share and hire cars are not permitted to stop on Alison Rd or Doncaster Avenue.

RideShare – please follow instructions from your preferred rideshare app. Patrons are advised that rideshare will only be permitted to collect from designated safe zones external to the venue.

CAR PARKING

There is limited FREE car parking in the infield car park. Entry to the infield car park is via High Street, opposite UNSW.

The Ascot Street Multi Deck carpark is available for the use of Australian Turf Club Members ONLY. Pre-booking is required for all days, please contact the Membership for information.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT COVIDSAFE REMINDER

Racegoers travelling by public transport are reminded that services continue to operate at a reduced capacity to maintain physical distancing across the network.

Allow additional travel time and plan ahead by checking real-time capacity indicators where available as you may need to wait for the next service with available physical distancing capacity.

Remember to practise physical distancing when on-board transport services and to look for the 'green dots' to find the safest places to sit or stand. At present, wearing a face mask while travelling on public transport is mandatory.
