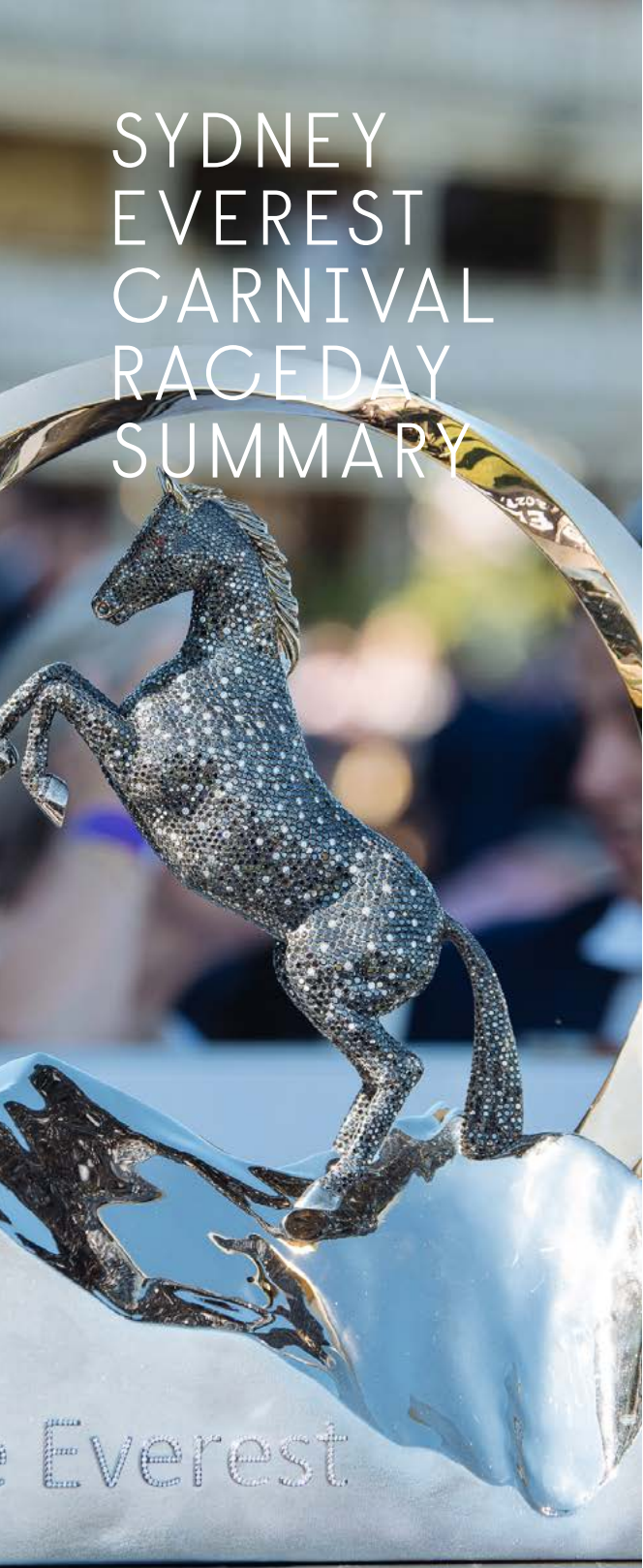

# FUJITSU GENERAL GEORGE MAIN STAKES DAY

The Fujitsu General George Main is the biggest Weight-For-Age mile of the Spring and is a critical lead up to the Epsom the fortnight beforehand.

Brilliant WFA horses have won this like Shannon, Kingston Town, Vo Rogue, Lonhro, More Joyous and Winx.

It was often the springboard for a Winx attack in three of her Cox Plates triumphs.

Yet another of Chris Waller's great band of mares was to the fore in 2021 as Verry Elleegant surged up the inside to win on a wet day at Randwick. She took her record to over \$9m in prizemoney and 9 x G1 wins.

Prizemoney for the Group 1 Fujitsu General George Main Stakes rises to \$1 million this year and the race remains a key form guide towards the \$1.5 million TAB Epsom.

Modern-day superstars such as Kingston Town, Vo Rogue, Lonhro and Winx have won the race.

After Winx won three times in a row in recent years, multiple Group 1 winner and inaugural Golden Eagle champion Kolding last year added a George Main to his imposing record.

The biggest handicap race during the Sydney Everest Carnival the \$1.5 million TAB Epsom is run over the world-famous Royal Randwick mile – from arguably the best starting point in the country.

Invariably a big field and open betting race, the honour roll is another spread with champions – from Super Impose’s rare double through to other recent stars including Filante, Racing To Win, Boban, Happy Clapper and the immortal Winx.

Super Impose added two Doncasters to his Epsom double, including carrying a hefty 61kg to win this race in 1991, creating “History at Randwick”.

Four-year-olds have an extraordinary record and it continued in 2021 when Private Eye came well back on the turn for a narrow win.

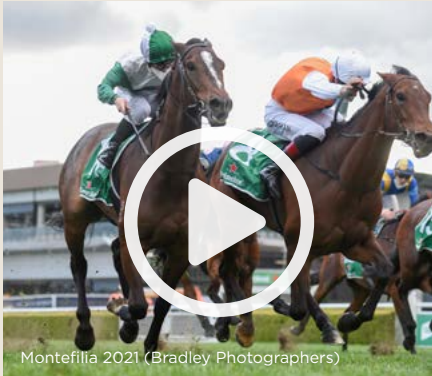

Racing NSW and the Australian Turf Club present the inaugural running of the \$2million Big Dance at Royal Randwick, another innovative race celebrating the growth of racing across NSW. The field for The Big Dance run over 1600m is from winners and second placed horses of 25 Country Cups. A Big Dance Wild Card race is also run at Royal Randwick on 15 October, with the winner and second placed horse from that race eligible and exempt from ballot. Benchmark rating at the time of final acceptances will determine the final field, with the winners of eligible Country Cups receiving preference. The Big Dance will be run at a distance of 1600m under quality handicap conditions. A headline musical act performing after the races, combined with the new Winx Stand for General Admission racegoers, will ensure a premium raceday experience to attract new customers to racing.

(1600m on same day, \$500K) - official winners, second and third placed horses of qualifying races for the Big Dance and otherwise balloted or ineligible for the Big Dance or eliminated as emergencies. 1. The relaxed "Boyfriend" style suit - the 2 piece pant suit is back. It's a little oversized and relaxed (even pant legs are also more relaxed or wide leg even).
2. Puffy sleeves and big shoulders are still trending this season. Pump up the volume for maximum exposure.
3. Dopamine dressing - Lots of bright bold fun colour especially the neon tones. If you don't feel comfortable rocking a bold colour outfit, consider bold bright coloured hats, clutches and heels.
4. Barbiecore is a global trend thanks to the upcoming Barbie movie and Valentino did a whole collection in pink. Pink will definitely be a huge colour trackside this spring.
5. Metallics - high shine fabrics, sparkly fabrics, sequins - this trend will definitely turn heads track side. Metallic pleats are a chic way to adopt this trend for the track".

## » ATC'S BEAUTY EXPERT MICHAEL BROWN'S 3 TRACKSIDE BEAUTY ESSENTIALS

**Sydney's go-to hair and makeup guru shares his three top tips to have you looking your best this Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival.**

### 1. Glossy lip

Spring is about embracing colour, but you also need to have balance with outfit tones. A juicy, glossy textured lip is a great way to add colour to lift a makeup look, plus be in-line with spring vibes, but not as opaque as a matte lip, which can pull focus.

A glossy lip is easier to maintain and always apply to the central lip area to avoid product build up on outer lip edge. If gloss is sheer, use a lip liner first ok entire lip to builds colour base and depth.

### 2. Metallic Eye

Trends are showing a big push in metallic eyelids, this really catches the spring light and is a great way to incorporate a colour tone from your chosen outfit or headwear to bring the overall look together. Metallic shadows are best used in the most central part of the mobile eyelid, and as close to the centre lash line as possible to really pop.

Use a lash or smoked eyeliner to define eyes and contrast from the metallic shade you choose, but don't add too much depth to the eye that you lose the metallic effect. Always use fingertips to apply and dab onto eyelid to avoid fall out.

### 3. Sleek Hair

Go big and go bold this Spring with headwear. Because of this don't overdo hair looks to outshine your chosen millinery. Sometimes the most simple hairstyles - like a beautifully smooth look with a little kick under and the ends for a touch of chic - works best to make other elements, like an outfit, lip colour and headwear pop.

Choose a hairstyle that complements your headwear and work around that piece for balance and if wearing your hair out, over styling with product can weigh your hair down so it won't last the distance. Texture spray over hairspray and very lightweight shine drops over a heavy oil.
