is the second leg of Sydney's breed shaping and lucrative 2YO Triple Crown.



- » Nature Strip would go into second all-time in Australian prizemoney history with his third TJ win.

Hasm more than 100 Group 1 winners on the CV, including those 25 with the immortal Winx forever etched in racing folklore. One of the world's elite jockeys.

TIM CLARK

Maintains a strong association with trainers Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott who again loom as a formidable force in the Sydney Autumn. Almost half of Tim's 22 Group 1s (by carnival beginning) have been with Tulloch Lodge. Likely to team up with cult horse Alligator Blood in perhaps a Star Doncaster or Longines Queen Elizabeth Stakes.

JAMES McDONALD

Rated the world's best jockey. A six-time Sydney premiership winner, JMac sits at 74 Group 1s before the season began. The world saw his talents at Royal Ascot aboard Nature Strip, and horse and rider now head toward an unprecedented fourth consecutive TJ Smith Stakes. Amongst many stars, James rides Australia's highest rated horse Anamoe.

RACHEL KING

Royal Randwick has been a happy hunting ground for Rachel King so far in her career, with Knights Order's Schweppes Sydney Cup last Autumn adding a second Group 1 to her rising career amongst the world's most competitive jockeys room. Adaptable jockey who has a knack with sprinters and stayers alike.

KERRIN McEVOY

The winner of more than 80 Group One races, count on Kerrin McEvoy to be in the thick of the action right across the Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival. Has won a Longines Golden Slipper and a Schweppes Sydney Cup - and races at many distances in between. Look for him to pair with the Peter and Paul Snowden stable.

NASH RAWILLER

One of Sydney's most successful jockeys with three premierships, Nash is a punter's favourite for his strength in the final stages to get horses over the line. His spectacular ride on Think It Over to win last year's Longines Queen Elizabeth Stakes, heading towards the outside rail. will be hailed for decades for its judgement, daring and tactical brilliance.

THE APPRENTICES

A group of NSW apprentices are being touted by former champion jockeys and trainers alike as amongst the most talented in many decades. Tyler Schiller sits entrenched in the top ten of the Sydney premiership, and Zac Lloyd, Dylan Gibbons and Reece Jones. watch for one or several to hit the headlines in Group races across the Sydney Autumn Racing Carnival.

HOW TO GET TO THE TRACK

ROSEHILL GARDENS

Rosehill Gardens is situated approximately 20km to the west of the Sydney CBD in what is the geographical heart of the city.

Three of the city's major vehicular arteries – Parramatta Road, Victoria Road and the M4 Motorway service Rosehill Gardens.

Schedules bus services run to Rosehill Gardens from Paramatta Station and Sydney Olympic Park, with increased services for raceday patrons.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Train Services

Trains run regularly to Parramatta where you can connect with buses to Rosehill Gardens.

Buses to/from Carlingford and Paramatta Station

Train replacement bus services (535 route) will operate daily with frequent stops from Valentine Avenue, Parramatta to Lloyds Avenue, Carlingford via Hassall Street, Rosehill.

The M92 service also operates to and from Paramatta Station.

There will be no disruption to accessing the P1, P3 and P4 car parks, and the Rosehill footbridge will remain open for entry to the property.

TAXI/RIDE SHARE

Set Down – Taxis enter Rosehill Gardens Racecourse through the Grand Avenue gates. The set-down point is at the taxi rank. Taxis are not permitted to stop on James Ruse Drive and Grand Ave.

Pick Up – Taxis are located at the Grand Avenue end of the racecourse adjacent to the Might and Power entry.

HIRE CARS & LIMOUSINES

Limousines enter Rosehill Gardens Racecourse via the Gate 1 P1 Members Entry. Set-down and pick-up is available. Please follow directions from gate staff. Onsite parking is not available.

CAR PARKING

There is limited FREE car parking in P4 / P5 car park located on James Ruse Drive & Prospect Street and P6 Infield car park. Entry to the Infield car park is via Gate 2 Unwin Street.

ROYAL RANDWICK

Royal Randwick is located on Alison Road in Sydney's Eastern Suburbs and is approximately 6km from Sydney CBD and 8km from Sydney Airport.

Royal Randwick is well serviced by public transport with Light Rail services running from Circular Quay and Central to Royal Randwick station, and a purpose built bus terminal and slipway located immediately outside the main racecourse entrance on Alison Road.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Light Rail

The new L2 or L3 Randwick Line services run between Circular Quay and Randwick via Central Station (Chalmers Street).

Catch a light rail service to the Royal Randwick stop on Alison Road which is opposite the racecourse or the L3 which arrives at Ascot Street Gate. Services run regularly from 5.00am until 1.00am on weekdays and weekends. During major events, frequent express shuttle services will also run.

Buses

Plenty of regular route buses also run between the City and Eastern Suburbs via Anzac Parade and Alison Road to get you to Randwick Racecourse including Routes M50, 339, 373, 374, 376 and 377.

TAXI/RIDE SHARE & HIRE CAR

Taxis enter Royal Randwick through the Ascot St gates. The set-down and collection point is at the secure taxi rank.

Hire Car Collection is permitted via Gate 1 on Alison Road AFTER 3.00pm.

Hire cars are advised that there is a STRICT 15 minute collection/waiting time. Please have your pre-booked passengers waiting at the Hire Car collection bay (GATE D) prior to entering the precinct.

Taxis, ride share and hire cars are not permitted to stop on Alison Rd or Doncaster Avenue.

RIdeShare – please follow instructions from your preferred rideshare app.
Patrons are advised that rideshare will only be permitted to collect from designated safe zones external to the venue.

CAR PARKING

There is limited FREE car parking in the infield car park. Entry to the infield car park is via High Street, opposite UNSW.

The Ascot Street Multi Deck carpark is available for the use of Australian Turf Club Members ONLY. Pre-booking is required for all days, please contact the Membership for information.
