Sydney Everest Carnival's biggest day of racing includes three Group 1 races.

A day that is loved by racing purists, TAB Epsom Day boasts over \$5million in prizemoney and is headlined by the \$1.5million TAB Epsom, \$750,000 James Squire Metropolitan and the final leg of the Darley Princess series - the \$750,000 Darley Flight Stakes.

A Randwick mile is always a tremendous contest with good quality and pace and superb finishes. As it is from the best starting point in the country, everyone gets their chance and many historic moments have occurred in this race.

Super Impose took out four straight 'big miles' in 1990 and 1991. Making them more remarkable was that he started with 57kg and the last one in the Epsom of 1991 saw him lump 61kg when it was 'History at Randwick'.

Well in terms of finishes, few can compare with the 2022 edition as it was three across the track and in the end it took the judge a good ten minutes to try and separate Top Ranked and Ellsberg and he was unable to do that.

INTERESTING FACTS:
» No horse has done the Epsom/ Caulfield Cup double in same year.
» Epsom/Cox Plate double – Nightmarch, Chatham, Noholme, Winx.
» Epsom/Doncaster (season) double – Dundee, Marvel, Chatham, Gunsynd, Super Impose, Winx, Happy Clapper.
» Marvel carried 64.5kg to win in 1891.
» Last true outsider to win was Final Fantasy when winning when the race was 1400m on the Kensington track at 50-1.
» One of the most famous winners was Shannon. He won in 1945 and then in 1946 under 9 stone 9, Shannon missed the start and did not move until the field travelled some distance. In the end he only just missed Blue Legend into second. It is said the starter failed to notice Shannon was not ready.
» Hartnell broke the famous Randwick mile track record winning the 2018 Epsom.
» Wide barriers are no hindrance with 12 of the last 18 being double figure draws.
» For only the third time in the race's history, there was a dead heat in the 2022 Epsom and it took over ten minutes to decide the photo between Top Ranked and Ellsberg.

» The Metropolitan/Caulfield Cup (4 times) – Tawqeet most recent in 2006.
» The Metropolitan/Melbourne Cup (5 times) – Macdougall most recent in 1959.
» Junoob was disqualified after winning the 2014 edition.
» Te Akau Nick won Gai Waterhouse her first Group 1 in the 1992 Metropolitan.
» Only one horse since 2005 has brought in winning form before taking it out (Glencadam Gold 2012)
» In consecutive years Railings and Tawqeet won the Caulfield Cup after the Metropolitan.
» Come Play With Me was the first winner of the race since The Verminator in 2011 to do all his racing in Australia.
» Montefilia gave Hugh Bowman his 100th G1 win (at the time) which was appropriate as winning trainer David Payne had also trained more than 100 G1s when in his homeland South Africa. Subsequent events meant it was his 99th but he would still reach the milestone in the Autumn.

The fillies main feature of the Spring is the Darley Flight Stakes and it produces good horses.

It is only fitting, as it is named after a brilliant filly/mare who would win two Cox Plates.

The race's honour roll provides a great indication as to its depth with the likes of Wenona Girl, Bounding Away, Sunline and More Joyous all winning.

Chris Waller had a rather famous one beaten in this race in 2014 but the 2022 race would not slip through his fingers as Zougotcha kept on rolling through the Spring carnival.

» Tea Rose Stakes/Flight Stakes double – Zougotcha, Funstar, Alizee, First Seal, Guelph, Streama, More Joyous, Samantha Miss, Cheeky Choice, Ha Ha, Unworldly, Danglissa, Sunline, Assertive Lass, Pontal Lass, Danarani, Angst.
» Yankee Rose was later disqualified after running second in 2016.
» Tulloch Lodge have an extraordinary record in the race and it continued in 2021.
» Assertive Lass and Dashing Eagle quinellad the Furious and Tea Rose Stakes in 1996 and then for good measure dead-heated in the Flight Stakes.
» In 2008, Samantha Miss became the first filly since Angst in 1993 to win all four legs of the Princess Series - the Silver Shadow Stakes, the Furious Stakes, the Tea Rose Stakes and the Flight Stakes.
» Montefilia backed up after winning the Flight to win the Spring Champion against the boys in 2020. She also won The Metrop on this day a year later.
» Not only did Never Been Kissed give Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott their 13th G1 together, it was also the race that provided their first via Global Glamour in 2016 – almost to the day.
» Zougotcha won the Silver Shadow, missed the Furious then won the Tea Rose and then the Flight.

WORLD’S RICHEST RACE ON TURF (1200M)
3YO & UP SET WEIGHTS
\$20,000,000

The Everest has quickly become Sydney’s biggest race and not just because of the massive prize money.

In 2022 we got back to huge crowds on course and over 46,000 were back to Randwick with the roar in the lead up to the gates opening a feature and them all joining in to ‘Sweet Caroline’.

While it is such a rich prize (now \$20million), to show the egalitarian nature of racing in Australia, a syndicate won the first two editions (along with their slot holder) with Redzel and then a 3yo in 2019 Yes Yes Yes broke the track record.

A big grey was back in the limelight at Randwick as Classique Legend flashed home in a ballistic edition in 2020. Then a grand sprinter in Nature Strip confirmed his elite performances winning the big one.

It was the 3yos once again in 2022 as Giga Kick stormed home from near the tail to run down some of the best in the world and win at the biggest price for an Everest winner.

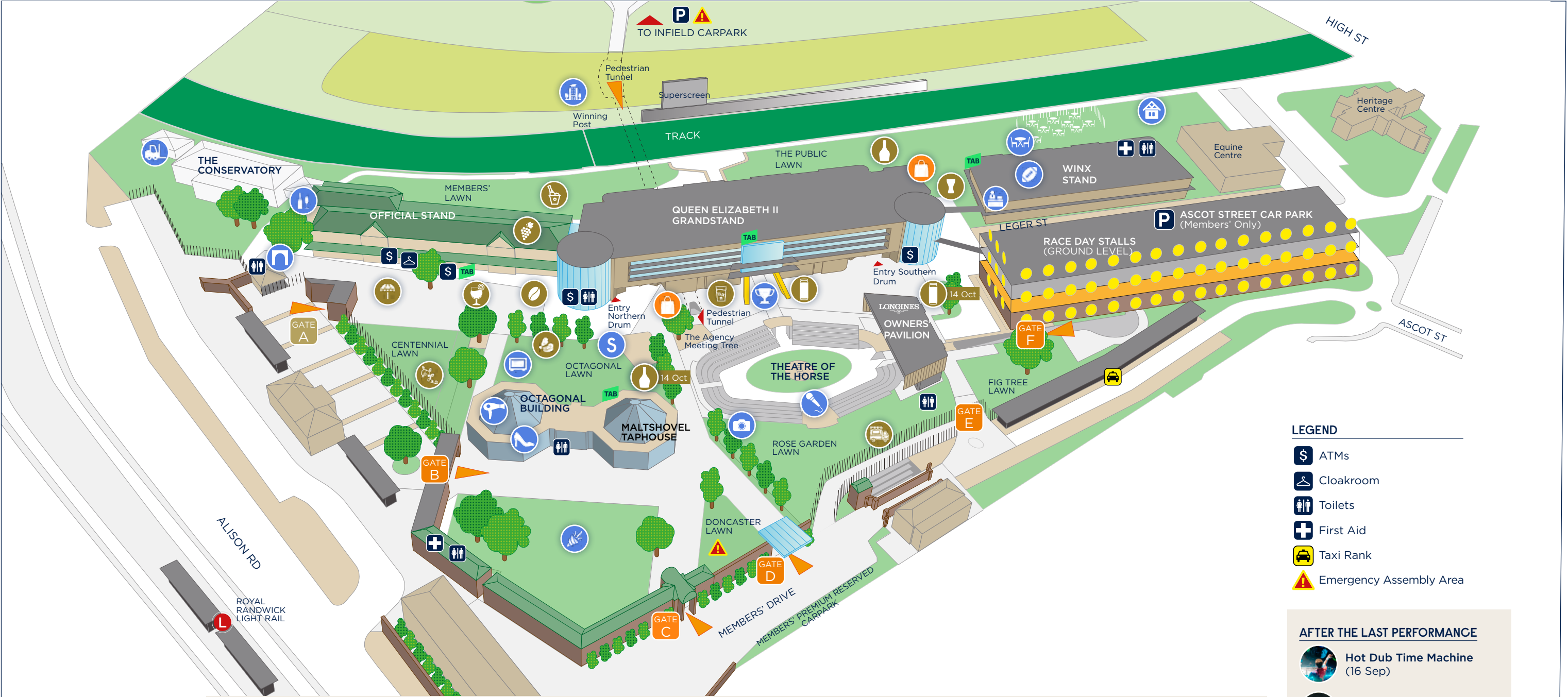

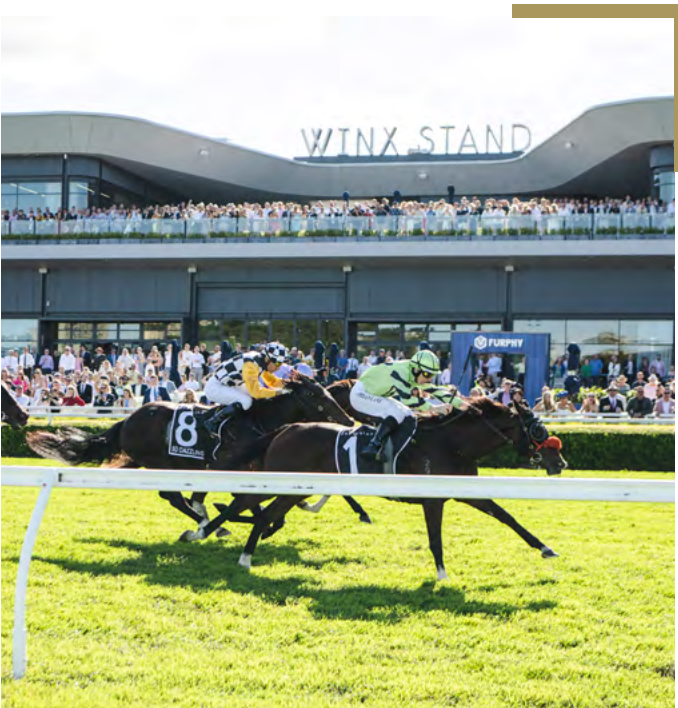
