TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The promoter of the Competition is the Australian Turf Club Limited (ABN 81 148 157 288) of Royal Randwick Racecourse, Alison Road, Randwick, NSW 2031, telephone: +61 2 9663 8400 (**Promoter**).
2. The Competition is a game of skill not chance. The Competition will be judged by a judging panel consisting of three judges selected by the Promoter (Panel).
3. Rules on how to enter the Competition form part of these Terms and Conditions of entry. The Rules can be found at <https://www.australianturfclub.com.au/fashionstakes> (Website). By entering the Competition or accepting a prize, entrants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
4. The Competition will be conducted between opening gates time and 2pm on:
 - a. TAB Everest Day, October 14th 2023.
 - b. James Squire Golden Eagle Day, November 4th 2023.
5. To enter the Competition, entrants must complete the entry form and include a photo of their outfit while on track. The photo can be taken by guests utilising the QR codes on course, or at the registration area in the Pamper Pavilion at Royal Randwick or the Pamper Lounge at Rosehill gardens.
6. There will be two best dressed winners selected on October 14 2023 and November 4 2023. (**Winners**).
7. By entering our competition, entrants agree to have their photo possibly displayed on Channel 7's raceday broadcast, ATC social media, on course digital displays, The Daily Telegraph website and 7 Racing social media at the Promoters discretion.
8. Entrants will be judged according to the guidelines;
 - a. An aesthetically pleasing Spring racing outfit.
 - b. The outfit must reference Spring racing dress codes and incorporate current trends, while expressing your own personal style.
 - c. The outfit should be styled with shoes, headwear and accessories.
 - d. Sophistication, creativity, and individuality are key.

9. Should the entrants not meet the judging guidelines, they will not be eligible as a finalist or winner.
10. Entrants must not be dressed or styled by a designer or milliner. Any entrant found to be dressed or styled by a designer or milliner will be automatically disqualified (at the Promoter's discretion).

12. Entrants must be 18 years of age or more each race day and a resident of Australia. Proof of age must be provided when claiming the major prize.
13. Entry to the Competition will be refused or an entrant disqualified if an entrant does not comply with these Terms and Conditions. The ATC reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and disqualify any entrant for tampering or attempting to tamper with the entry process.
14. In the case of disqualification after the winner's announcement has taken place, the initial winner will be contacted to notify them of their disqualification and the runner up will instead be named the winner and receive all associated prizing.
15. At the close of registration each race day (2.00pm), a top 20 finalists will be determined. The judges will then vote for their top six entries. The finalists will be invited onto the Presentation Stage where the Winners will be announced on course by the MC, as well as digital displays on course and social media. They will be directly notified via the contact details provided on their entry form. Finalists must be on course and available for the Winners Announcement.
