The world's richest race on turf - the \$20million TAB Everest. Twelve horses do battle over 1200 metres in a test of sustained speed from some of the best sprinters in the world. The sixth running of the TAB Everest will have the eyes of the world firmly set on Royal Randwick.

The TAB Everest has quickly become Sydney's biggest race and not just because of the massive prozemoney.

In 2022 we got back to huge crowds on course and over 46,000 were back to Royal Randwick with the roar in the lead up to the gates opening a feature and them all joining in to 'Sweet Caroline'.

While it is such a rich prize (now \$20million), to show the egalitarian nature of racing in Australia, a syndicate won the first two editions (along with their slot holder) with Redzel and then a 3yo in 2019 Yes Yes Yes broke the track record.

A big grey was back in the limelight at Royal Randwick as Classique Legend flashed home in a ballistic edition in 2020. Then a grand sprinter in Nature Strip confirmed his elite performances winning the big one.

It was the 3yos once again in 2022 as Giga Kick stormed home from near the tail to run down some of the best in the world and win at the biggest price for a TAB Everest winner.

- INTERESTING FACTS:**
- » The first three winners were basically the same price.
 - » Then in 2020 Classique Legend became the first favourite to win.
 - » Nature Strip would add his name to a favourite to win but even he was \$3.75.
 - » Giga Kick became the biggest priced winner at 20-1 in 2022.
 - » Horses who predominantly raced interstate started favourite in the first three Everests (Vega Magic/Shoals/ Arcadia Queen). Giga Kick became the first interstate trained winner.
 - » Kerrin McEvoy made it three Everests to go with three Melbourne Cups with the 2020 win.
 - » Giga Kick joined Redzel in Year 1 as the only horses to bring in winning form and score.
 - » The 2021 trifecta was the same as the TJ Smith run six months earlier.
 - » Horses to compete in more than two Everests – Nature Strip (4), Redzel, Santa Ana Lane, Classique Legend, Trekking and Eduardo (3).
 - » 10 x 3yos have run – 3 Fillies, 4 Colts, 1 gelding and 2 Northern Hemisphere Colts.
 - » Most Rides (6) - Kerrin McEvoy (3 wins).
 - » Most Horses Trained (8) - Chris Waller (2 wins), James Cummings.
 - » Lost And Running became the first horse to be scratched on race day and was replaced by slotholder Tabcorp with Kementari.

Sydney's biggest mile Weight-For-Age contest of the Spring just got bigger in 2023.

The George Main Stakes has been renamed as the King Charles III Stakes and upped to \$5m in prizemoney.

It has also moved from being before the Epsom to a month later making TAB Everest day even bigger.

Some grand horses like Shannon, Kingston Town, Vo Rogue, Lonhro, More Joyous and Winx. It was often the springboard for a Winx attack in three of her Cox Plates triumphs.

Yet another elite horse won the race in 2022 as Anamoe showed his undoubted class. He even showed a little lameness post-race making the win even more impressive.

INTERESTING FACTS:
» Was previously run the week before the Epsom but now is run a month after that on Everest day.
» Tramway/King Charles III (6 times) – Sincero most recent in 2011.
» Warwick (Winx) Stks/King Charles III (14 times) – Anamoe most recent in 2022.
» Only one double figure odds winner in 20 years – Road To Rock.
» Chris Waller has won 8 of the last 11 renewals.
» Winx 2018 win was number 27 in a row extending her Australian record.
» Verry Elleegant won her ninth G1 race at the time in taking out the 2021 running – interestingly they were nine different G1 races.

Royal Randwick is home to the world-class WINX Stand which is open for all racegoers.

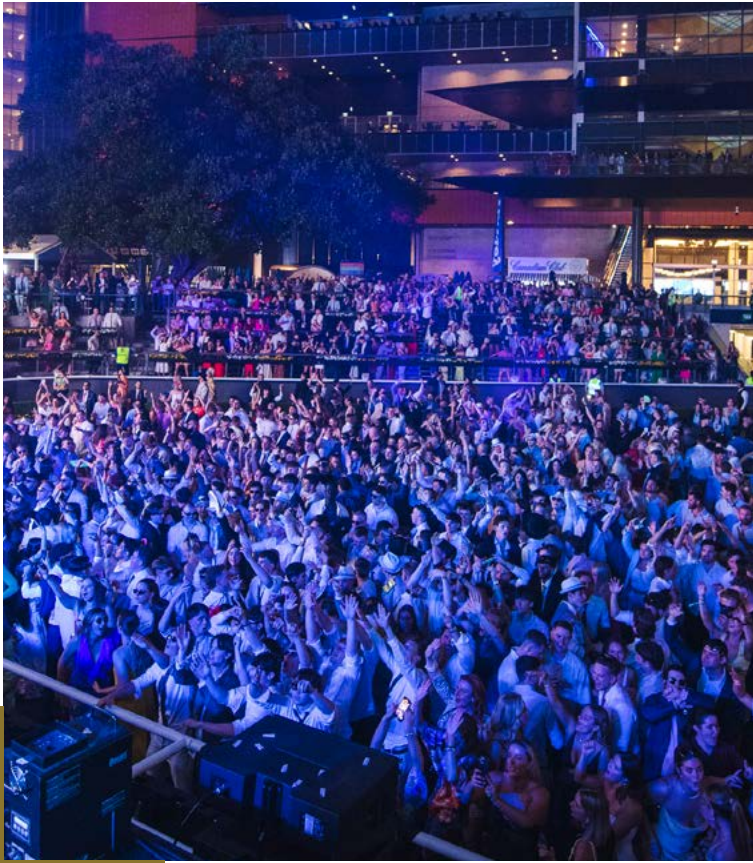
